

# J.P. Morgan Events: A Vehicle for Buyers and Sellers to Forge New Connections

By Dennis Ford, Founder & CEO, Life Science Nation (LSN); Creator of RESI Conference Series

Today, life science conferences still lead as a place to make new business connections in addition to accessing the latest information on the advances in drugs, devices, diagnostics, and healthcare IT, but I will posit that if information-based conferences don't get partnering right, they will become vulnerable, as there is a distinct and growing need from both buyers and sellers to build business connections at these events.

A lot of the information-based, super-technical scientific conferences that cater to academia and very early-stage discoveries have found themselves in the crosshairs of big pharma and other large partners who are moving upstream to find technology that isn't already identified and partnered up. This is a reason why these early stage scientific conferences are now in need of a partnering component. And to do partnering correctly, the conference provider should understand that it takes a high amount of human resource allocation; it is expensive to fund, and requires deep curation of a clientele database for each conference iteration. LSN has discovered that our database curation begets savvy list management, which in turn allows us to target constituents and provide them with customer support and training to use the partnering system efficiently.

JPM Week is a prime example of information-based conferences turning into relationship-based conferences.

Based on the five years of experience in the partnering conference marketplace, I will say this: Great partnering is very hard to get right, it's resource intensive and it is "high touch". You do successful partnering by creating a consistent dialogue with your constituents. This entails focused communications via newsletter promos, emails and telephone canvassing. You need a dedicated staff who reach out (yes, talk with!) and understand both the buy-side and sell-side needs of the clients. The staff's job is to talk to clients and understand their needs and keep a record of those needs, what technology they are interested in, and who they are seeking to meet. If you initiate and continue this compelling dialogue, it soon turns into a relationship, and having a direct relationship with your clients is the holy grail.

Lastly, conference providers should want great partnering NOT "me too" partnering. For example, LSN's style of interactive dialogue and relationship building through business development is very different than that of information-based conference organizations. LSN's thesis is that we are NOT a conference company; we are a buyer seller matching platform with a conference, and that's what gives RESI's partnering platform its incredible power to forge new connections. # Top Ten BioWeekSF Survival Tips from LaVoieHealthScience

- 1. The time is now. It's not too early to start outreach to those with whom you want to meet, and it's never too late to stop. While some will fill their calendars early, others know to leave some slots for late-breaking requests (see Tip 10).
- **2. Extend your reach.** Target 20% new names. Not sure how you'll find them?Use the resources of a third party, be it a hightech platform or a high-touch agency.
- **3.** Refresh your pitch. Some things never change, but others should. Make sure your message and positioning clearly articulate your current vision and opportunity. Need help? Refer to LHS Immersion®.
- **4. Divide and conquer.** Don't do every meeting with every co-worker. Branch off to different meetings and events to ensure full value for your time in San Francisco.
- **5. Disconnect and conquer.** Try turning off your phone. Really. This will force you to focus on the people in front of you.
- **6.** Know your audience. It's tempting to tell your audience everything you possibly can about your product, platform or service. Don't. 15 slides are plenty. See LHS' 15-Slide Presentation® for insight.

- 7. Don't go too green. It's easy to forego hard copy collateral however a hand-out can support the real-time conversation, while ensuring an imprint beyond the meeting itself. Paper or pixels? Both, please.
- **8.** Consider an Infographic. Pictures are really worth 1,000 words, so there is no need to overwhelm your counterparty with text. Use infographics to depict your company's story in a creative and informative manner.
- 9. Have (most of) a plan. Things get changed and rescheduled quickly in San Francisco; leave some holes in your calendar for impromptu meetings and onthe-spot networking. You may miss an athand opportunity if your scheduled is overbooked.
- 10. **Follow up.** Schedule time after you're back in the office to follow up with the contacts you made in San Francisco. Nothing is easier than getting jammed back into your day-to-day work; ensure you've penciled in time to debrief.
